HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

GRADUATING WITH ACCOLADES

Students with a GPA of 3.5 or higher graduate with honors according to the following guidelines:

- Cum Laude: Graduating with Honor means graduating cum laude. GPA for cum laude 3.5 to 3.79
- Magna Cum Laude: The magna cum laude definition is With Great Honor. GPA for magna cum laude 3.8 to 3.99
- Summa Cum Laude: Most define summa cum laude as With Highest Praise. GPA for summa cum laude -4.0+
